

Lyra Taylor Social Work Impact Summit 2025 Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Promoter Details

The Promoter is the Australian Association of Social Workers, ABN 93 008 576 010, located at Level 7, 14-20 Blackwood St, North Melbourne, 3051.

2. Eligibility

The draw is open to current residents of Australia aged 18 years or older. Employees of the Promoter (and their immediate families – including spouses, de facto partners, children, parents, and siblings) are not eligible to enter.

AASW contractors, agencies, staff or consultants, are not eligible to enter.

3. Competition Period

The prize draw closes at 5:00pm AEST on Friday 31 October 2025. Entries received after this time will not be eligible.

4. How to Enter

To enter, eligible participants must register and pay for the Lyra Taylor Social Work Impact Summit 2025 by the closing date of 5:00pm AEST on Friday 31 October 2025. Entry is automatic upon summit registration. Only one entry per person is permitted. Entry is deemed received at the time the payment is confirmed.
